Financials As of our June 13th meeting we had \$14,495.16 in our checking account of which \$4,000 is set aside for scholarships. Our savings/investment accounts have \$28,451.91 of which a portion is restricted. Will close scholarship savings and move to investment account. Investment accounts will then be 50% scholarship and 50% general fund in multiple CD's (e.g. 3, 6, 9 months 4.5% or better). Bond funds not paying much.
