

QUARTERLY NEWSLETTER – APRIL 2024

Financials As of our March meeting we had \$5,651.93 in our checking account of which \$500 is set aside for a new flag pole plaque in Memorial Park. Our savings accounts have \$30,536.86 of which a portion is restricted for Scholarships (\$16,881.88) and Honor Guard (\$6,409.99). Renters have vacated and remodeling/fixing costs could be between \$5,000-\$8,000.
