

QUARTERLY NEWSLETTER – JULY 2024

Financials Due to the high cost of apartment remodeling (over \$8,500) and the fact that we found foundation repairs necessary under the apartment stairway (\$9,000) as well as installation of new gutters on the apartment stairway side (\$700) as well as final payment on the flag pole plaque in River Park, we were forced to close our investment savings accounts. This is in spite of donations of \$3,500 for the apartment remodeling and \$1,000 for foundation work from 3 members. As of our July meeting we have \$ 285.00 in our checking account for miscellaneous monthly costs as well as \$16,858.16 which is set-aside for scholarships. Our scholarship awards of \$4,000 in August will be taken from this set-aside. The Honor Guard account has \$7,310.77. If unforeseen major bills come up in the near future we will use this account to cover these costs. We also have a renter paying \$850/month.
